Aurora Acetic Acid 90%. Acetic acid /ə'si:tkl/, systematically named ethanoic acid / ə'noʊɪk/, is an acidic, colourless liquid and organic compound with the chemical formula CH_3COOH (also written as $\text{CH}_3\text{CO}_2\text{H}$, $\text{C}_2\text{H}_4\text{O}_2$, or $\text{HC}_2\text{H}_3\text{O}_2$). Vinegar is at least 4% acetic acid by volume, making acetic acid the main component of vinegar apart from water. It has been used, as a component of vinegar, throughout history from at least the third century BC .
